Summary of Teaching Experience

I have had the opportunity to design and teach a broad range of undergraduate courses: Introductory and Intermediate Microeconomics, Public Choice, Money and Banking, and International Economic Policy. Each course begins with a review of economic principles, and each further concept or topic is linked back to the fundamentals. For example, how does the intersection of supply and demand explain the U.S. political climate, or predict the effects of tariffs, or even a student's housing options? Exams, problem sets, and quizzes utilize true/false/explain and short answer questions to measure understanding of both core concepts and the ability to critically apply the material. These assignments, which are typically challenging, encourage student engagement, deeper thought, and allows me to pinpoint a student's conceptual difficulties.
